



- Jn 7:7 The **world** cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it that its works are evil.
- Jn 8:23 And He said to them, “You are from beneath; I am from above. You are of this **world**; I am not of this **world**.”
- Jn 12:31 Now is the judgment of this **world**; now the ruler of this **world** will be cast out.
- Jn 14:17 the Spirit of truth, whom the **world** cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.
- Jn 14:27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the **world** gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
- Jn 14:30 I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this **world** is coming, and he has nothing in Me.
- Jn 15:18 “If the **world** hates you, you know that it hated Me before *it hated* you.
- Jn 15:19 If you were of the **world**, the **world** would love its own. Yet because you are not of the **world**, but I chose you out of the **world**, therefore the **world** hates you.
- Jn 16:11 of judgment, because the ruler of this **world** is judged.
- Jn 16:20 Most assuredly, I say to you that you will weep and lament, but the **world** will rejoice; and you will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into joy.
- Jn 17:9 “I pray for them. I do not pray for the **world** but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours.
- Jn 17:14 I have given them Your word; and the **world** has hated them because they are not of the **world**, just as I am not of the **world**.

- Jn 17:18 As You sent Me into the **world**, I also have sent them into the **world**.
- Jn 17:25 O righteous Father! The **world** has not known You, but I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me.
- 1 Co 1:20 Where *is* the wise? Where *is* the scribe? Where *is* the disputer of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this **world**?
- 1 Co 1:21 For since, in the wisdom of God, the **world** through wisdom did not know God, it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe.
- 1 Co 1:27 But God has chosen the foolish things of the **world** to put to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the **world** to put to shame the things which are mighty;
- 1 Co 1:28 and the base things of the **world** and the things which are despised God has chosen, and the things which are

- not, to bring to nothing the things that are,
- 1 Co 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.
- 1 Co 3:19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, “*He catches the wise in their own craftiness*”;
- 1 Co 5:10 Yet I certainly *did not mean* with the sexually immoral people of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or idolaters, since then you would need to go out of the world.
- 1 Co 6:2 Do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if the world will be judged by you, are you unworthy to judge the smallest matters?
- 1 Co 7:31 and those who use this world as not misusing it. For the form of this world is passing away.
- 1 Co 11:32 But when we are judged, we are chastened by the Lord, that we may not be condemned with the world.
- 2 Co 7:10 For godly sorrow produces repentance *leading* to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.
- Ga 4:3 Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world.
- Ga 6:14 But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.
- Eph 2:2 in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience,
- Col 2:8 Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ.
- Col 2:20 Therefore, if you died with Christ from the basic principles of the world, why, as *though* living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations—
- Heb 11:7 By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.
- Heb 11:38 of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, *in dens* and caves of the earth.
- Jas 1:27 Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, *and* to keep oneself unspotted from the world.
- Jas 4:4 Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.
- 2 Pe 1:4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption *that is* in the world through lust.
- 2 Pe 2:20 For if, after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the latter end is worse for them than the beginning.
- 1 Jn 2:15 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
- 1 Jn 2:16 For all that *is* in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.
- 1 Jn 2:17 And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.
- 1 Jn 3:1 Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.
- 1 Jn 3:13 Do not marvel, my brethren, if the world hates you.
- 1 Jn 3:17 But whoever has *this world’s* goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?
- 1 Jn 4:1 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.
- 1 Jn 4:3 and every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of God. And this is the *spirit* of the Antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world.
- 1 Jn 4:4 You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.
- 1 Jn 4:5 They are of the world. Therefore they speak *as* of the world, and the world hears them.

- 1 Jn 5:4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith.
- 1 Jn 5:5 Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?
- 1 Jn 5:19 We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one.
- 2 Jn 7 For many deceivers have gone out into the world who do not confess Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.

- Mt 24:21 For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.
- Lk 9:25 For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself destroyed or lost?
- Lk 11:50 that the blood of all the prophets which was shed from the foundation of the world may be required of this generation,
- Jn 1:9 That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world.
- Jn 1:10 He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.
- Jn 3:17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.
- Jn 3:19 And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.
- Jn 6:14 Then those men, when they had seen the sign that Jesus did, said, “This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world.”

- Ro 1:20 For since the creation of the world His invisible *attributes* are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,
- Ro 5:12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned—
- Ro 5:13 (For until the law sin was in the world, but sin is not imputed when there is no law.)
- 1 Co 3:22 whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas, or the world or life or death, or things present or things to come—all are yours.
- 1 Co 4:9 For I think that God has displayed us, the apostles, last, as men condemned to death; for we have been made a spectacle to the world, both to angels and to men.
